### **Appendix 2**

#### **NICE 2010 COPD Referral Criteria**

1.2.5.4 The need for oxygen therapy should be assessed in:

- all patients with very severe airflow obstruction (FEV1 < 30% predicted)
- patients with cyanosis
- patients with polycythaemia
- patients with peripheral oedema
- patients with a raised jugular venous pressure
- patients with oxygen saturations  $\leq$  92% breathing air.

Assessment should also be considered in patients with severe airflow obstruction (FEV1 30–49% predicted). [2004]
