1) Case Identification

The following codes should be used to identify cases **aged >16 years** with a **primary discharge diagnosis** of pneumonia:

- J12 Viral pneumonia
- J13 Pneumonia due to S. Pneumoniae
- J14 Pneumonia due to H. Influenzae
- J15 Bacterial pneumonia not elsewhere classified
- J16 Pneumonia due to other infectious organism
- J17 Pneumonia in diseases classified elsewhere
- J18 Pneumonia: organism unspecified

2) Checking cases against the Screening Criteria

Ideally, all identified cases should be screened against the following inclusion and exclusion criteria. Cases should be included in Part 1 of the audit if BOTH of the inclusion criteria apply and NONE of the exclusion criteria.

Inclusion Criteria:

- New infiltrates on chest x-ray performed within 24 hours of admission
- Acute onset of symptoms and signs of LRTI

Exclusion Criteria:

- Hospital admission within the 10 days prior to index admission
- Immunocompromised
- Treated for aspiration pneumonia
- Transfer from another hospital

Points to note:

To exclude patients with non-pneumonic LRTI please review the admission CXR of each case to ensure that new pulmonary infiltrates consistent with infection are present. If there no new infiltrates are present on admission CXR or if no CXR was performed, please exclude from the audit and record the reason on the screening data sheet.
